Materials

Needles

4mm circular needle (UK 8 – US 6)
4mm double pointed needles (optional)

Buttons

1 small button
4 stitch holders

Tension

19 stitches and 27 rows to
10cm (4in) over stocking stitch
on 4mm needles

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING. If you tension square has less stitches, use a thinner needle, if more, use a thicker needle.

Abbreviations

Special Stitches

M1L: make 1 left: with lhn pick up bar between last st worked and next st from front to back and knit through back of loop

M1R: make 1 right: with lhn pick up bar between last st worked and next st from back to front and knit through front of loop

SLEEVES (Make 2)

With straight needles cast on 41[44:49:52]sts

Row 1 (WS): purl

Row 2: k1[2:1:2], *yo, k2, s2kpo, k2, yo, k1; rep from * to last 0{2:0:2}sts, k0[2:0:2]

Repeat Rows 1-2 twice more

Next row: p2tog 1[0:1:0] times, purl to end (40[44:48:52]sts)

Slip remaining sts onto a stitch holder.

BODY

Note: cardigan is knit flat from the bottom up

Using thumb method and circular needle, cast on 123[133:143:153]sts

Row 1 and all ws rows: k6, purl to last 6 sts, k6

Rows 2, 4, 6 & 8: k7, *yo, k3, sk2po, k3, yo, k1; rep from * to last 6 sts, k6

Rows 10, 12, 14 & 16: k6, k2tog, *k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, sk2po; rep from * to last 15 sts, k3, yo, k1, yo, k3 skpo, k6

Rows 18, 20 & 22: k7, *M1L, k3, sk2po, k3, M1R, k1; rep from * to last 6 sts, k6

Row 23: k6, purl to last 6 sts, k6

Next row: knit

Next row: k6, purl to last 6 sts, k6

These two rows set Body patt.
Repeat these two rows until
body measures 13[14:16:18]cm
(5[5½:6¼:7]ins) from cast on
edge (Note: measure edge of
garter stitch border, rather than
through pattern as stitch creates
an uneven edge).

Join Sleeves

Next row: k 33[35:39:41]sts from
Body, slip next 8 sts onto a stitch
holder, slip first 4 sts of sleeve
onto holder, knit across centre
32[36:40:44] sts from sleeve,
leaving the edge 4 edge stitches
on another stitch holder, knit
across 41[47:49:55]sts for Back,
slip next 8 sts onto a stitch
holder, slip first 4 sts of sleeve
onto holder, knit across centre
32[36:40:44] sts from sleeve,
leaving the edge 4 edge stitches
on another stitch holder, knit
across 33[35:39:41]sts for front
(171[189:207:225]sts

Continue straight in Body patt
until yoke measures 6[7:9:10]cm
(2¼[2¾:3½:4]ins) from underarm,
ending on a ws row.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (RS): k7, (k2tog) to last 6
sts, k6 (96[101:110:119]sts)

Row 2: k6, purl to last 6 sts, k6

Row 3: k6[7:6:7], (k2tog) to last 6
sts, k6 (54[57:61:66]sts)

Knit 3 rows

Buttonhole row: k3, yo, k2tog,
knit to end

Knit 3 rows.

Cast off.

MAKING UP

Join sleeve seams and graft
underarm sts using Kitchener st.
Weave in loose ends. Block as
desired. Sew button in place.
