Needles Tension **Buttons**

1 pair of 5mm (UK 6 – US 8) 1 pair of 6mm (UK 4 - US 10)

3.5mm crochet hook (optional)

3 buttons

14 stitches and 20 rows to 10cm (4in) over stocking stitch

on 6mm needles

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING. If you tension square has less stitches, use a thinner needle, if more, use a thicker needle.

BACK

Using 5mm needles and Col A cast on 44[48:52:56:60]sts.

Row 1: *k2, p2; rep from * to

end

Row 2: As Row 1

Last two rows form 2x2 rib pattern.

Work a further 6 rows in 2x2 rib.

Change to 6mm needles and Col

B and starting with a knit row, work 8 rows in stst.

Change to Col C and work 8 rows in stst.

Change to Col D and work 4 rows in stst.

Change to Col A and cont in stst, dec 1 st at each end of next and each foll 18th[18th:20th:20th:22nd]row until 38[42:46:50:54]sts remain.

Cont in stst without shaping until Back measures 12[13:14:15:16]ins (30[33:35.5:38:40.5]cm).

Shape Raglan

Cast off 2sts at beg of next 2 rows. (34[38:42:46:50]sts)

Next row: k2, k2tog, k to last

4sts, k2togtbl, k2 Next row: purl

Repeat last two rows until 14[14:16:16:18]sts remain, ending with a w/s row.

Cast off loosely.

Stripe pattern for front and sleeves

Col B: stst 8 rows
Col C: stst 8 rows
Col D: stst 4 rows
Col A: stst 10 rows
Col E: stst 8 rows
Col D: stst 4 rows

Repeat

LEFT FRONT

With 5mm needles and Col A cast on 24[26:28:30:32]sts.
Work 8 rows in 2x2 rib.

Change to 6mm needles and Col B and continue in stripe patt (see above) until front measures 12[13:14:15:16]ins (30[33:35.5:38:40.5]cm) ending with a w/s row on the same row of stripe patt as Back.

Shape Raglan

Keeping in stripe patt continue as follows:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row. (22[24:26:28:30]sts).

Next row: purl

Next row: k2, k2tog, patt to end

Next row: purl

Repeat last two rows until 15[15:16:16:17]sts remain, ending with a rs row.

Next row (w/s): Cast off 6[6:7:7:8]sts, purl to end. (9sts)
Next row: k2, k2tog, patt to last

2 sts, k2tog. (7sts)
Next row: purl

Next row: k2, k2tog, patt to end.

(6sts)

Next row: purl

Next row: k2, k2tog, k2 (5sts)

Next row: purl

Next row: k2tog, k2tog, k1 (3sts)

Cast off.

FRONT RIGHT

With 5mm needles and Col A cast on 24[26:28:30:32]sts.
Work 8 rows in 2x2 rib.

Change to 6mm needles and Col

B and continue in stripe patt (see above) until front measures 12[13:14:15:16]ins (30[33:35.5:38:40.5]cm) ending with a w/s row on the same row of stripe patt as Back.

Work 1 row.

Shape Raglan

Keeping in stripe patt, continue as follows:

Next row: Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row. (22[24:26:28:30]sts).

Next row: k to last 4sts, k2togtbl, k2

Next row: purl

Repeat last two rows until 15[15:16:16:17]sts remain, ending with a w/s row.

Next row (r/s): Cast off 6[6:7:7:8]sts, knit to last 4 sts, k2togtbl, k2. (8sts)

Next row: p2tog, patt to end.

(7sts)

Next row: k to last 4 sts,

k2togtbl, k2. (6sts)

Next row: purl

Next row: k2, k2tog, k2 (5sts)

Next row: purl

Next row: k2tog, k2tog, k1 (3sts)

Cast off.

SLEEVES (make two)

Using 5mm needles and Col A cast on 28[32:34:38:40]sts and work 8 rows in 2x2 rib.

Change to 6mm needles and Col

B and continue with Stripe Patt, inc 1 st at each end of 19th and foll 19th row until you have 32[36:38:42:44]sts.

Continue straight until sleeve measures 12[13:14:15:16]ins (30[33:35.5:38:40.5]cm), ending on the same row of stripe patt as Back.

Raglan shaping

Continue in Stripe Patt:

Next row: cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. (28[32:34:38:40]sts) Next row: k2, k2tog, k to last 4

sts, k2togtbl, k2
Next row: purl

Repeat last two rows until 8 sts remain, ending with a w/s row. Cast off loosely.

HOOD (Left)

With 6mm needles and Col A cast on 20[20:21:22:24]sts
Continue straight in stst until hood measures
12[12½:13:13½:14]ins
(30[32:33:34.5:35.5]cm) ending with a w/s row.

Next row: cast off 8[8:9:9:10]sts, knit to end. (12[12:12:13:14]sts)

Next row: purl

Next row: cast off 6sts, knit to

end. (6[6:6:7:8]sts)

Next row: purl

Work 9 rows in stst.

Cast off.

Cast on.

HOOD (Right)

With 6mm needles and Col A cast on 20[20:21:22:24]sts

Continue straight in stst until hood measures
12[12½:13:13½:14]ins
(30[32:33:34.5:35.5]cm) ending with a r/s row.

Next row: cast off 8[8:9:9:10]sts, knit to end. (12[12:12:13:14]sts)

Next row: knit

Next row: cast off 6sts, purl to end. (6[6:6:7:8]sts)

Work 10 rows in stst.

Cast off.

LEFT FRONT BORDER

Join Raglan seams. Stitch back seam of Hood. Join Hood to Body around neck. Sew sleeve seams and side seams.

Starting at top edge of Hood, pick up 3 out of every 4 sts down left front of Hood and Left Front of Body, and pick up 6 sts from bottom rib rows.

Work 5 rows in 2x2 rib. Cast off in Rib.

RIGHT FRONT BORDER

Starting at bottom of Right Front, pick up 6 sts from rib rows and 3 out of every 4 sts up Right Front of Body and Right front of Hood. Work 5 rows in 2x2 rib.

Cast off in Rib.

Join top Hood seam.



BUTTON LOOPS

Col A attach yarn to edge of right hand buttonband level with neck shaping/hood.

Ch10 and reattach approx. ½ in (1cm) below start of loop. Secure. Repeat twice more at intervals of approx. 1½ in (4cm).

Alternatively:

Using 5mm needles and Col A cast on 10sts. Cast off. Make 3 of these in total and secure to Right buttonband as outlined above.

TASSLE

From each colour cut 5 x 6in lengths of yarn and make a tassle. Lay all lengths evenly together and take one length and tie around centre. Secure, but do not cut. Fold lengths in half and take another length and tie around all approx ½ in (1cm) from where folded. Secure and cut ends. Trim all ends to same length.

Using uncut ends of length used to tie in half, secure the tassle to the top back point of hood.
