Hooks

4mm

Tension

To achieve stated size, completed motifs (rounds 1-5) should measure 10.5-11cm².

Abbreviations

ch	chain
ch sp	chain space
dc	double crochet
dtr	double treble
htr	half treble
tr	treble crochet
ss	slip stitch
yoh	yarn over hook

2-tr-cl two treble cluster [*yoh, insert hook in ch sp, yoh and pull a loop through, yoh and pull through 2 loops, repeat from * in same stitch, yoh and pull loop through all 3 loops on hook.]

3-tr-cl three treble cluster [*yoh, insert hook in stitch indicated, yoh and pull through a loop, yoh and pull through 2 loops, repeat from * twice more in same stitch, yoh and pull loop through all 4 loops on hook.]

Instructions:

Motif

Rounds 1-3 of each motif are made in one of the motif colours and rounds 4-5 are always worked in the main colour (Harvest).

Make 81 motifs - 9 in each motif colour.

The completed motifs are then joined together and a border added. Do not turn the motif at the end of each round.

Motif pattern:

Ch4 and join to first ch with a ss to make a ring.

Round 1: Ch4, (tr, ch) into ring 11 times, ss to third ch of starting ch to join.

Round 2: Ss into next ch space. Ch2, 2-tr-cl into same ch sp. Ch2, 3-tr-cl into next ch sp, *ch3, dtr into next tr, ch3, (3-tr-cl into next ch sp, ch2) twice, 3-tr-cl into next ch sp. Repeat from * two more times, ch3, dtr into next tr, ch3, 3-tr-cl into next ch sp, ch2, ss to join to beginning of round in top of first cluster.

Round 3: Ch1, dc in same place. *Ch2, tr4 into next ch sp, ch2, dtr into next dtr, ch2, tr4 into next ch

sp, ch2, dc into top of middle cluster. Repeat from * twice more.

Repeat from * once more to final ch2 then ss to dc at start of round. Fasten off and join in ends.

Round 4: Working in Harvest join yarn in one corner dtr. Ch1, 3dc in same place. *Work (dc, htr, tr) into next ch sp, ch2, tr3 into dc from previous round, ch2, (tr, htr, dc) into next ch sp, ch2, 3dc into next dtr. Repeat from * twice more. Repeat from * once more to final ch2 and ss to join to first dc.

Round 5: Ch1, dc in same place, 3dc in next dc (corner stitch), dc into each stitch along first side to corner dc, 3dc into corner dc. Repeat around rest of motif, ensuring 3dc are worked into each corner dc. Ss to first dc to join.

There should be 20dc between each corner dc. Fasten off and join in ends.



Joining

Arrange the motifs in diagonal rows of each colour as shown in the picture, or your preferred arrangement. Working in main colour (Harvest) first join the motifs in horizontal rows, adding on a row at a time and then complete the joining vertically.

To join place two motifs right side together, and dc through back

(outside) loops only into each stitch. Without fastening off pick up the next two motifs right sides together and continue to dc into each stitch. Continue in the same way to join all squares. Alternatively sew the motifs together.

Border

Border round 1: Continuing to work in Harvest, join yarn near a corner and dc in each stitch (both loops) ensuring 3dc are worked into each corner dc. Join with ss to first dc.

Round 2: Ch1, dc in each dc around edge, working 3dc into each of the four the corner stitches. TIP! If the sides are not straight, i.e. there are indents where the motifs are joined, use htr instead of dc near the joins. Join with ss to first dc.

Round 3: Ch1. Work in crab stitch (reverse dc) in each dc around edge. After working final st do not ss into first crab st, instead break off yarn and thread tail on a wool needle. Thread through first crab dc and weave in tail and all other ends. Wash according to instructions on the ball band and dry flat.



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
