



CY1 273 CHENILLE CHUNKY CHILDREN'S SLIPPERS IN 3 SIZES

You Will need –

Chenille Chunky in 2 colours of your choice (Honeydew 4175 & Misty Grey 4029, Petrol 4999 & Misty Grey 4029, Midnight 4054 & Misty Grey 4029)

6 mm crochet hook

Darning needle

1 Bottle of sock stop

Pattern Notes

UK terminology used

Use the finished sizes as a starting point, you will be prompted when to adjust the length.

It is best to try the actual slipper foot as you go to get the best possible fit.

The numbers at the end of each round in brackets, are the amount of stitches you should have at the end of that row.

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch. Always work into the 1st stitch of the row unless otherwise stated.

It is very important to apply sock stop as these slippers may be very slippery on some hardwood floors.

Finished slipper sizes -

Small – instep 15 cm , width 7 cm, length 14 cm.

Medium – instep 19 cm , width 9 cm, length 19 cm.

Large – instep 21 cm , width 11 cm, length 23 cm.

Abbreviations –

dc – double crochet

htc – half treble crochet

cc – contrasting colour

mc – main colour

bet – between

ch - chain

slst - slip stitch

rept - repeat

st(s)– stitch(s)

rem - remaining

t - turn your work

nxt - next

sp(s) – space(s)

fo – fasten off



Small –

With cc ch 2

Row 1 – in 2nd ch from hook, 6 x dc, slst to 1st dc (6)

Row 2 – ch1, 2 x dc into every st, slst to 1st dc (12)

Row 3 and 4 – ch1, dc into every st, slst to 1st dc, fo cc

Row 5 – attach mc, ch 1 and htc in every st around, slst to 1st htc

Rows 6 to 8 – ch1, htc into the sps bet the sts, rept around, ss to 1st htc (12)

Try your slipper on at this point and make sure it is reaching the correct instep height for your foot.

You may need to adjust the size a little, adding extra rows or ripping a few back. Once you have your correct height, fo mc.

Count 4 sts to the right of where you have just fastened off attach the mc into the sp bet the sts

Row 9 – ch1, working in the sp bet the sts work 8 htc

Rows 10 to 13 – ch1, t, in the sp bet the sts work 11 htc, htc in last sp

Continue repeating row 13 until your slipper is long enough to fit snugly around the heel, fo leaving a 6-inch tail

With your tail on a darning needle, hold the edges together and whip stitch both sides together using only the outer loops.

Work from the top all the way to the bottom, taking care to match the sts equally on either side, fo mc

Trim -

Row 1 - Attach cc at heel and ch1, work dc all the way around the edge, slst to the 1st dc (approx. 16 sts)

Fasten off, weave in all ends and apply sock stop.

Medium –

With cc ch2

Row 1 – in 2nd ch from hook, 8 x dc, slst to 1st dc (8)

Row 2 – ch1, 2 x dc into every st, slst to 1st dc (16)

Rows 3 to 5 – ch1, dc into every st, slst to 1st dc, fo cc

Row 6 – attach mc, ch1 and htc into every st around, slst to 1st htc

Rows 7 to 10 – ch1, htc into the sps bet the sts, rept around, slst to 1st htc (16)

Try your slipper on at this point and make sure it is reaching the correct instep height for your foot.

You may need to adjust the size a little, adding extra rows or ripping a few back. Once you have your correct height, fo mc

Count 6 sts to the right of where you have just fastened off attach the mc

Row 11 – ch1, working the sps bet the sts work 12 htc

Rows 12 to 17 – ch1, t, in the sp bet the sts work 11 htc, htc in last st

Continue repeating row 17 until your slipper is long enough to fit snugly around the heel, fo leaving a 6-inch tail

With your tail on a darning needle, hold the edges together and whip stitch both sides together using only the outer loops.

Work from the top all the way to the bottom, taking care to match the sts equally either side, fo mc

Trim -

Row 1 - attach cc at heel and ch1, work dc all the way around, slst to the 1st dc (approx. 21 sts)

Row 2 - ch1, in the sp bet the sts work dc around, slst to the 1st dc

Fasten off, weave in all ends and apply sock stop.

Large –

With cc ch2

Row 1 – in 2nd ch from hook, 10 x dc, slst to 1st dc (10)

Row 2 – ch1, 2 x dc into every st, slst to 1st dc (20)

Rows 3 to 6 – ch1, dc into every st, slst to 1st dc, fo cc

Row 7 – attach mc, ch1 and htc in every st around, slst to 1st htc

Rows 8 to 13 – ch1, htc into the sps bet the sts, rept around, ss to 1st htc (20)

Try your slipper on at this point and make sure it is reaching the correct Instep height for your foot.

You may need to adjust the size a little, adding extra rows or ripping a few back. Once you have your correct height, fo mc

Count 7 sts to the right of where you have just fastened off attach the mc

Row 14 – ch1, working into the sp bet the sts work 14 htc

Rows 15 to 20 – ch1, t, in the sp bet the sts work 13 htc, hdc into last st

Continue repeating row 20 until your slipper is long enough to fit snugly around the heel, fo leaving a 6-inch tail

With your tail on a darning needle, hold the edges together and whip stitch both sides together using only the outer loops.

Work from the top all the way to the bottom, taking care to match the sts equally either side, fo mc

Trim -

Row 1 – Attach cc at heel and ch1, work dc all the way around, slst to the 1st dc (approx. 24 sts)

Row 2 - ch1, into the sp bet the sts work dc around, slst to the 1st dc

Fasten off, weave in all ends and apply sock stop.



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
