Materials

Everyday Pato DK Apple 988 or Aqua 992					

Needles

4 pair of needles
4.5mm pair of needles

3 stitch holders

Tension

19 stitches and 28 rows to 10cm
(4in)

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING. If your tension square has less stitches, use a thinner needle, if more, use a thicker needle.

Abbreviations

k	knit	kfb	knit front and back of loop	s1	slip stitch	dec	decrease

Cr3f	cable 3 front: slip next 3 sts onto a cable needle and hold at front of work, P1, K3 from cable needle						
Cr3b	cable 3 back: slip next sts onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, K3, P st from cable needle.						

Back:

Using 4mm Knitting Needles cast on 72[76,80,84]sts

Work 10 rows in K1, P1 rib

Change to 4.50mm Knitting Needles and commence pattern.

Row 1: P9[11,13,15],[K3, P8]x5,K3, P5[7,9,11]

Row 2: K5[7,9,11], (P3, K8)x5,P3, K9[11,13,15]

Row 3: P9[11,13,15],[K3, P8]x5,K3, P5[7,9,11]

Row 4: K5[7,9,11], (P3, K8)x5,P3, K9[11,13,15]

Row 5: P8[10,12,14],[cr3b, P7]x5,cr3b, P5[7,9,11]

Row 6: K6[7,10,12], (P3, K8)x5,P3, K8[10,12,14]

Row 7: P7[9,11,13],[cr3b, P7]x5,cr3b, P6[8,10,12]

Row 8: K7[9,11,13], (P3, K8)x5,P3, K7[9,11,13]

Row 9: P6[8,10,12],[cr3b, P7]x5,cr3b, P7[9,11,13]

Row 10: K8[10,12,14], (P3, K8)x5,P3, K6[8,10,12]

Row 11: P5[7,9,11],[cr3b, P7]x5,cr3b, P8[10,12,14]

Row 12: [K9]11,13,14], (P3, K8)x5,P3, K5[7,9,,11]

Row 13: P5[7,9,11],[cr3b, P7]x5,cr3b, P9[11,13,15]

Row 14: K9[11,13,15], (P3, K8)x5,P3, K5[7,9,,11]

Row 15: P5[7,9,11],[cr3b, P7]x5,cr3b, P9[11,13,15]

Row 16: K9[11,13,15], (P3,

K8)x5,P3, K5[7,9,,11]

Row 17: P5[7,9,11],[cr3f, P7]x5,cr3f, P8[10,12,14]

Row 18: K8[10,12,14], (P3, K8)x5,P3, K6[8,10,12]

Row 19: P6[8,10,12],[cr3f, P7]x5,cr3f, P6[9,10,12]

Row 20: K7[9,11,13], (P3, K8)x5,P3, K7[9,11,13]

Row 21: P7[9,11,13],[cr3f, P7]x5,cr3f, P5[8,9,11]

Row 22: K6[8,10,12], (P3, K8)x5,P3, K8[10,12,14]

Row 23: P8[10,12,14],[cr3f, P7]x5,cr3f, P5[7,9,11]

Row 24: K5[7,9,11], (P3, K8)x5,P3, K9[11,13,15]Repeat

these 24 rows until work measures 8[9,10,11] ins from beg

Shape Raglan:

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows

Next row: K2, ssp, patt to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2

Next row: P3, patt to last 3 sts, P3 ****

Keeping pattern correct continue decreasing in this way until 28[28,30,30]sts remain.

Place sts on holder, break yarn.

Front:

Work as for Back to ****

Shape Neck:

Continue decreasing in this way until 42[46,48,50]sts remain

Next row: K2, ssp, patt 13, turn

Next row: Patt to last 3 sts, P3
Working on these 14 sts only dec 1 st at Raglan edge as before. At the same time dec 1 st at neck edge on next 5 rows
Continue dec 1 st at Raglan edge only until 3 sts remain.
Next row: K1, K2tog
Next row: K2tog
Fasten off.

Slip centre 12 sts onto a holder.
Rejoin yarn to remaining sts and complete as for other side reversing shaping's

Sleeves:

Using 4mm Knitting Needles cast on 34[36,38,40]sts

Work 10 rows in K1, P1 rib

Change to 4.50mm Knitting Needles

1st row: P12[13,14,15] K3, P8, K3, P8[9,10,11]

2nd row: K8[9,10,11], P3, K8, P3, K12[13,14,15]

These 2 rows set position for centre pattern.

Continue working in pattern increasing 1 st at each end of 3rd and every following

4th rows until 56[58,60,62]sts are on needle.

Continue working straight until sleeve measures 9[10,11,12]ins from beg

Shape Raglan:

Work as for back until 14[14,16,16]sts remain
Place sts onto a holder

Neck:

Using 4mm needles, join Raglan seams leaving back left seam open.

With right side of work facing knit across sts at top of sleeve as follows - K3[3,5,5], (K2tog, K1)x3, K2[2,4,4], pick up and knit 14[14,15,15]sts evenly down left front, knit across centre sts as follows - K2, (K1, K2tog)x3, K1, pick up and knit 14[14,15,15]sts evenly up right front, knit across sts at top of sleeve as follows - K3[3,5,5], (K2tog, K1)x3, K2[2,4,4], Knit across sts at back as follows – (K1, K2tog)x9, K1[1,3,3] (78[78,90,90]sts

Work 7 rows in K1, P1 rib

Break off yarn. Thread a contrast yarn through all sts and remove from needle

Fold neck in half to inside and slip stitch the stitches from the yarn to the inside of the neck.

To make up:

Join remaining Raglan and neck seam

Sew side and sleeve seams
